

If you complete a Graduate Diploma of Applied Finance or a Master of Applied Finance, you can choose to specialise in a particular area of professional practice.

How many subjects do I need to complete?

If you are enrolled in the **Graduate Diploma of Applied Finance** and wish to undertake a specialisation, you must complete the three (3) required subjects from the appropriate specialisation as indicated in the table below, in addition to the two (2) core subjects (FIN101 and FIN103) and further three (3) electives.

If you are enrolled in the **Master of Applied Finance** and wish to undertake a specialisation, you must complete the three (3) required subjects from the appropriate specialisation as indicated in the table below, in addition to four (4) core subjects (FIN101, FIN103, FIN201 and KAP001) and a further five (5) electives.
